The Appalachian State University MS in Nutrition offers two different tracks that equip graduates with the knowledge and skills to excel as Registered Dietitian Nutritionists. The App State MS in Nutrition integrates graduate coursework with experiential learning to shape the future leaders in nutrition and dietetics.

Course Overview:

MS/DI: Traditional combined MS & Dietetic Internship. The first year includes in-person coursework in Boone, followed by a 1,000 hour dietetic internship at sites in NC.

PHN/Dietetics: Enroll in fully-online courses that build on prerequisite knowledge and enhance preparation for 1080 hours of supervised experiential learning. The program length is 2 years.

MS/DI: Hold a bachelor's degree from an ACEND DPD program and obtain a DPD Verification Statement

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PHN/Dietetics: DPD Verification Statement not required. Completed bachelor's degree with science prerequisites, including: Introduction to Psychology (3), Basic Food Science (3), Nutrition and Health (3), Introduction to Chemistry I (4) w/ Lab, Introduction to Statistics (3), Human Anatomy and Physiology (4), Biological Concepts I (4), Fundamentals of Organic Chemistry (4), Medical Terminology (1) and Food Safety Course or ServSafe/Food Manager Certification

GRE is not required for either program.
